CHET Advance Scholarship**DUE TUESDAY OCT 3**

This Scholarship is a program offered by the Connecticut State Treasurer's Office to help students pay for college. This academic year, CHET Advance will award up to \$500,000 in scholarships during the Fall of 2018. A total of 200 scholarships are available. Up to 100 scholarships will be awarded to high school SENIORS, and up to 100 scholarships will be awarded to high school FRESHMEN. For seniors, the scholarship award will be \$2,500. For freshmen, \$2,000 will be set aside initially, and each student has the opportunity to receive an additional \$500 match for a total award of \$2,500.
